

PHILIP COCHRANE WINS SINGLES AND DOUBLES TITLES AT CARDIFF



12 year old Philip Cochrane, who is in Year 8, recently took part in the Esporta Cardiff Wheelchair Tennis Tournament, part of the NEC World Tour, held at the Welsh National Tennis Centre.

In the Singles event he was untroubled in the early rounds dropping only 7 games in two matches. In the Final he started impressively taking the first set 6-2 but had to fight off a spirited response from his opponent, Andrew Laphorne (West London), before taking the set 7-5 and the match.
