Students will have the opportunity to experience the day as a Sixth Form student and therefore can wear casual/smart clothing.

All students will be given a comprehensive information pack during the day, containing important information, such as the expected subjects on offer, enrichment opportunities, a Sixth Form Course Booklet and general information about Chepstow School Sixth Form Centre.

There will be a follow-up appointment on Thursday, 15th December with their form tutors to discuss progress and current performance. At this appointment students can also discuss their initial option choices for the Sixth Form.

As you will be aware, mock GCSE examinations will commence in January 2012, and following these results, students will have a second meeting with a senior member of staff, to discuss in more detail, their option choices. Parents are very welcome to attend this interview.
